Applicants will forfeit their scholarship back to the NJROTC scholarship fund if they are denied or decline admissions to college by the Fall Semester of the award year.
- f. Applications must be completed in their entirety and submitted to the Spring High School NJROTC Booster Club by email to springjrotcboosterclub@gmail.com no later than Wednesday June 15, 2022.
- g. Scholarship awardees will be notified of award by Thursday, 30 June 2022.
- h. Scholarships shall be awarded at the discretion of the Booster Club based upon merit, performance in the NJROTC program, and meeting the above criteria.
